2019 Young Men's Scholarship Application

Eta Eta Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. has established an educational grant to assist eligible African-American male high school graduates who wish to continue their education beyond high school. Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. is an African-American fraternity, which was founded in 1906 on the fundamentals of scholarship, fraternal fellowship, and service to mankind.

The scholarships, which have a one-time award value of \$500.00 - \$1,000.00, will be paid to each honoree's chosen school after receipt of confirmed enrollment in the college, university or technical school. The honorees will receive a public presentation of this award at each student's high school Senior Awards Program during May 2019. Also, they will be invited to attend another presentation of the award before the members of the fraternity at the annual Young Men's Conference on May 11, 2019.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates must:

- Apply for admission to an accredited university, college or technical school
- Demonstrate the need for financial assistance
- Demonstrate participation in school and community activities and leadership roles
- Demonstrate academic achievement in high school (GPA = 2.5 or higher)
- Completed application package must be received by **Friday, March 22, 2019**.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

1. Complete the 3-page application and essay. Use the accompanying fillable-PDF file, <<apa_scholarship_application(2019).pdf>>
2. Student and parent/guardian sign the application (page 3)
3. Provide two personal references prepared by adult non-family members (example: school counselor, teacher, coach, religious leader, employer). Use the accompanying fillable-PDF file, <<apa_scholarship_application(2019)-personal reference.pdf>>
4. Provide a current high school academic transcript in a sealed envelope.
5. Provide proof of 2018 income for the student applicant and each parent or legal guardian in the household (photocopy of 2018 W-2s; blackout the individual's Social Security Number) [**Do not** send the complete IRS-1040 Tax Report].
6. Mail the completed application, personal essay references, and transcript to:
