- Application packages must be received by <u>Friday</u>, <u>March 17</u>, <u>2017</u>.

- 2. Student and parent/guardian sign the application (page 3)
- 3. Provide two personal references prepared by adult non-family members (example: school counselor, teacher, coach, religious leader, employer). Use the accompanying fillable-PDF file, <<apa scholarship application (2017)-personal reference.pdf>>
- 4. Provide a current high school academic transcript in a sealed envelope.
- 5. Provide proof of 2016 income for the student applicant and each parent or legal guardian in the household (photocopy of 2016 W-2s; blackout the individual's Social Security Number) [**Do not** send the complete IRS-1040 Tax Report].
