2020 Young Men's Scholarship Application

Eta Eta Lambda Foundation, Inc. has established an educational grant to assist eligible African American male high school graduates who wish to continue their education beyond high school. This award is inspired by the goals of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., an African American fraternity which was founded in 1906 on the fundamentals of scholarship, fraternal fellowship, and service to mankind.

The scholarships, which have a one-time award value of \$500.00 - \$1,000.00, will be paid to each honoree's chosen school after receipt of confirmed enrollment in the college, university or technical school.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates must:

- Apply for admission to an accredited university, college or technical school
- Demonstrate the need for financial assistance
- Demonstrate participation in school and community activities and leadership roles
- Demonstrate academic achievement in high school (GPA = 2.5 or higher)
- Completed application package must be received by **Friday, March 20, 2020**.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

1. Complete the 3-page application and essay. Use the accompanying fillable-PDF file, <<apa_scholarship_application(2020).pdf>>
2. Student and parent/guardian sign the application (page 3)
3. Provide two personal references prepared by adult non-family members (example: school counselor, teacher, coach, religious leader, and employer). Use the accompanying fillable-PDF file, <<apa_scholarship_application(2020)-personal_reference.pdf>>
4. Provide a current high school academic transcript in a sealed envelope.
5. Provide a copy of the student's most recent FAFSA Student Aid Report.
